Book Retrieval Information

Requested ARC Library items are retrieved on a regular basis throughout the day. Items are retrieved approximately every 2 hours, and may not be ready for pick up for 1 to 2 hours after retrieval. If an item is requested after the last run of the day, the item won't be available for pick up until after the first scheduled run of the next day.

For example:

If you request an item before 9 am on Tuesday, a library staff member will retrieve the item at 9 am.

The item should be ready to be picked up by 11 am.

If an item is requested at 2 pm on Saturday the item will not be retrieved until 9 am Monday morning, and should be ready for pickup by 11 am.
