

Hello, I'm David McCusker. I'm one of the librarians at American River. This brief video will show you how to get into the library's databases from off-campus.

To use the databases from off campus, you do have to be currently enrolled in classes and have all your fees paid.

You can find a link to the library's homepage under "Academics" on the college's homepage. From the library's homepage, you'd click on "Research Databases."

At that point, you'll be asked which school you attend. You'd click on American River College.

You'd then see the databases page. Click on the database you'd like to use.

At this point, you'll be asked to login. In the first box, type a w and then your student id number. In the second box, type your unified password. This is the same password that you'd use to access eservices. You'll then be able to start using the database.

If you don't remember your student id number or your password, you can look these up on the eservices page.

If you can't get into the database and you know you're using the correct login information and you're currently enrolled in classes, call the library's circulation desk. You can find their contact information on the library's website.
