FIRE INVESTIGATION 1B

TECHNIQUES OF FIRE INVESTIGATION

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Fire Investigation 1B is a 40-hour course designed to build the necessary skills to determine the cause of fire, its human and environmental effects, and to develop interpersonal skills needed to successfully investigate, apprehend, and convict the arsonist. Topics include: Criminal law; search and seizure; evidence collection and laboratory services; fire death investigation; fire behavior and effects; interview and interrogation techniques; general insurance procedures and construction costs; surveillance; court demeanor; and fire causes.

Once a student passes this course, the course cannot be repeated.
