ADULT CORRECTIONS OFFICER CORE COURSE

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Adult Corrections Officer Core Course is a 179-hour course, offered over a four and one-half week period. Testing on the various topics covered will be both written and demonstrated. Hands-on training is utilized for report writing and oral interview skills. Major topics include: role and responsibilities of the Corrections Officer, adult criminal justice system and process, evasive self-defensive and restraint procedures, to include ground fighting techniques, indicators of psychological problems, classification factors for inmates, handling disputes, court testimony, visitation procedures, intake and release procedures.

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.

PREREQUISITES: High School Diploma or GED

MATERIALS NEEDED: Appropriate attire is required for all physical training. Students need to be prepared for the rigor of the physical conditioning and defensive tactics training. Pre-existing medical conditions may interfere with successful completion of these sections and/or the course.
