CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL TRAINING (CPT) OF HEALTH SERVICES, FOOD & DRUG

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Continuing Professional Training (CPT) is an 8-hour course designed to review techniques and update CPR skills and to refresh students Basic Academy skills with emphasis on control holds, handcuffing and defense against aggressive suspects.

The course will consist of Weaponless Defense Tactics Update Training.

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.

This course is being presented for California Department of Health Services, Food and Drug Branch.

Successful completion of a Basic Law Enforcement Academy or equivalent as determined by Dean.
