BASIC CRIME PREVENTION

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Basic Crime Prevention is a 40-hour course offered to all persons interested in Crime Prevention. This course is designed to address the following topics: General overview of Crime Prevention, Crime Prevention programs, local/state/national resources, environmental design, school violence prevention, development/maintenance of volunteer programs, the role of a crime prevention practitioner, high tech crime and fraud, security surveys, basic hardware, public speaking, COPPS/POPPS, and liability issues.

PREREQUISITES: None

MATERIALS NEEDED: Students representing agencies are to bring 30 copies of their agency’s pamphlets, brochures, advertisements and/or educational materials utilized for public information. These examples will be shared with other students. Students must also bring a ½” blank VHS tape for self-assessment.
