COURSE DESCRIPTION: Drug and Alcohol Recognition (DAR) is a 24-hour, P.O.S.T. and S.T.C. certified course designed to train officers to observe and testify to the affects of drugs and alcohol on the human body. Content includes legal aspects, human physiology, cannabis, PCP, opiates, stimulants, hallucinogens, depressants, drug toxicology, investigative techniques and courtroom testimony. May be substituted for 11550 H & S.
