## California Highway Patrol & the SRPSTC Drug Recognition Evaluator Course

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** Drug Recognition Evaluator (DRE) is an extensive, advanced officer drug impairment training course leading to a State Certification through the California Highway Patrol and International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) Credentialing. The DRE is an effective means of identifying and prosecuting drug impaired individuals and has become the accepted standard throughout the United States, primarily due to the accuracy and effectiveness of the evaluator.

**PREREQUISITES:** This course is an advanced drug influence training course for law enforcement officers, which complies with the national standards established by the IACP. Students **are required** to have previous training in National Highway Traffic Safety Administration Standardized Field Sobriety Testing.

**Students must provide a copy of their SFST certificate at time of registration.**
