## FINGERPRINT IDENTIFICATION (BASIC)

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** Basic Fingerprint Identification is a 40-hour course that provides basic instruction in the Henry classification system and practical application in identifying patterns and comparing ink print to ink print. This class is designed for law enforcement personnel who will be making ink comparisons on a routine basis. This course is required for those students wishing to take a Latent Print Course in the future.
