FIREARMS INSTRUCTOR (UPDATE)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Firearms Instructor Update is a 24-hour course designed to update experienced firearms instructors who have previously completed the Basic Firearms Instructor Course. Topics include: Legal updates, liability issues, police officer shooting statistics, police officer shooting concerns, course lesson plan development, multiple officers shooting positions, close quarter combat drills, target analysis and shooter problems, student courses of fire.

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.

PREREQUISITES: Successful completion of a POST certified firearms instructor course, or equivalent as determined by Dean.

FIREARMS INSTRUCTOR (UPDATE)

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT

1. If duty weapon is a revolver, bring at least 2 speed loaders with pouches
2. If duty weapon is a semi-auto pistol, bring at least 3 magazines and 2 pouches
3. Agency/Department Approved duty holster, belt and accessories
4. Agency/Department Approved patrol shotgun
5. Ammunition needed, 850 handgun rounds (No reloads, round nose ammunition recommended), 150 shotgun rounds, bird shot or trap shot
6. Ballistic protective vest
7. Ear and eye protection
8. Clothing suitable for outdoor range (trousers with belt loops, belt) and rain gear, if appropriate
9. Notebook, pen and notebook paper
10. Baseball cap
11. Knee/elbow protection
12. Copy of Department shooting policy

Optional equipment: Personal lap top computer for lesson plan
 Water bottle
 Sunscreen/Sun Block
 Beverage Cooler / Lunch Box / Lunch Bag due to lack of services
 near the range
