FIREARMS/RIFLE INSTRUCTOR (UPDATE)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Firearms/Rifle Instructor Update is a 24-hour course designed to instruct others in the use of the patrol carbine in general patrol use, close quarters combat, and active shooter response. Emphasis will be on the use of the weapon by the patrol officer/deputy/state trooper in a combat environment.

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.

This course meets the requirements set forth in 12020(b) 1 of the California Penal Code in regards to the use of short barreled rifles as set forth by the POST Commission.

PREREQUISITES: Successful completion of a POST certified firearms instructor course, or equivalent as determined by the department Dean.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT
