IMPACT WEAPONS INSTRUCTOR (UPDATE)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Impact Weapons Instructor Update is a 16-hour course designed to update impact weapon instructors in the use of all conventional police impact weapons, to function as an in-house trainer, and to evaluate various options for his/her agency in the use of impact weapons. The instructor should be certified in the use of the following impact weapons: 26' baton, side handle baton, YWARA, KABATON, SHORT BILLY, LONG BATON, and the HANDLER 12, the O.P.N., and the expandable baton (ASP and Winchester).

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.

PREREQUISITES:

Must have successfully completed an Approved 80-hour Impact Weapons Instructor Course AND show proof of completion the first day of the class. Those students who cannot show proof will not be allowed to participate.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

Gym clothes, agency issued Impact Weapon, work out gloves, or boxing hand wrap or tape for fingers, notebook, and pen.
