IMPACT WEAPONS INSTRUCTOR

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Impact Weapons Instructor is an 80-hour course designed to train law enforcement officers to instruct in the use of all conventional police impact weapons, to function as an in-house trainer, and to evaluate various options for his/her agency in the use of impact weapons. The instructor will be certified in the use of the following impact weapons: 26' baton, side handle baton, SHORT BILLY, LONG BATON, the O.P.N., and the expandable baton (Yawara/Kubaton and similar or like weapons).

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.

PREREQUISITES:

All students must have successfully completed a POST/STC/C-POST approved academy or equivalent as determined by Dean. Students must show documentation the first day of class.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

This is a physically demanding course and participants should be in good physical condition. Participants with prior injuries should be cleared by their agency physician for intense physical activity. Protective equipment is provided. Those persons unable to fully participate in the physically demanding course will be dismissed from the class.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

Students are required to bring agency issued impact weapon, tape for hands and/or workout gloves, notebook, pen, sweats and tennis shoes.
