COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Latent Fingerprint Identification and Comparison (Advanced) is a 40 hour course designed to introduce advanced methods of Latent Fingerprint Identification and Comparison, ACE-V scientific method, NCIC Classification and AFIS formulas. Provides essential knowledge necessary to present expert fingerprint courtroom testimony.

Must have successfully completed the 40-hour Basic Fingerprint Identification & Classification course, or the 40-hour FBI Basic Fingerprint Classification Course, or an equivalent course recognized by the Dean of the Sacramento Regional Public Safety Training Center.
