PC 832 FIREARMS FAMILIARIZATION

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

PC 832 Firearms Familiarization is a 24-hour course designed to cover the legal, moral and safety aspects of firearms use, range firing and qualification, weapon care and cleaning. It complies with the requirements of Section 832 of the Penal Code. Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participant.
Attendance is mandatory. No late arrivals or absences are permitted.

**** PLEASE DO NOT BRING YOUR PERSONAL OR DEPARTMENT ISSUED FIREARM AND/OR AMMUNITION, UNLESS IT HAS BEEN PRE-APPROVED BY THE SRPSTC. PRE-APPROVAL ALSO REQUIRES A WRITTEN REQUEST FROM YOUR DEPARTMENT HEAD, RECEIVED BY SRPSTC PRIOR TO THE START OF THE COURSE.**

ENROLLMENT:

All students are required to register prior to the first day of class to ensure they are current in our system. To register, please submit an on-line application to American River College (ARC) each semester. Please go to our website: www.arc.losrios.edu/safety. Click on "Registration", fill out all required fields and submit the application. ARC e-Services will send out two e-mails, one will be a confirmation of the application and the second will contain your permanent student identification number. Please contact us with your Student Id Number prior to the first day of class; this can be done by phone, fax or email.

State law mandates SRPSTC have a current Department of Justice clearance letter for each student prior to registration. The Live Scan Form must be submitted to D.O.J. and can be accessed from our website at www.arc.losrios.edu/safety. Click on "Forms", then "D.O.J Live Scan Forms", and fill in the required fields. Print three (3) copies and submit the paperwork to the D.O.J, address provided on the Live Scan Form. Once the paperwork is processed, D.O.J. will send a clearance letter to the address on the Live Scan Forms. Students must provide the SRPSTC with a copy of their D.O.J. clearance letter prior to the start of the course. This can be done by phone, fax or email.
