REGULATORY INVESTIGATIVE TECHNIQUES

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Regulatory Investigative Techniques is a 40-hour course designed to provide training in the basic principles, methods, and techniques used while conducting a regulatory investigation. Emphasis will be on the practical application of the participant's ability to plan, organize and conduct an investigation in a professional manner. Subject areas that will be covered: Role of the investigator, source of information, other civil and criminal remedies, subpoenas and warrants, the administrative hearing process, planning your investigation, legal aspects of investigation, giving testimony and expert witness, investigative note-taking and report writing.
