SUPERVISORY CORE COURSE (STC)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Supervisory Core Course (STC) is an 80-hour course designed for the new supervisor in corrections, probation, Juvenile Hall counselors, and state investigators. This course includes practical experience in conducting evaluations, ethics, and team building. Major topics include: role of the supervisor, supervisory skills, vicarious liability, legal update, effective communications, how to discipline, counseling, and situational leadership.

PREREQUISITES: Successful completion of Basic Peace Officer or Specialized Investigator courses or equivalent as determined by Dean.
