TACTICAL CASUALTY CARE - UPDATE

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course is designed for law enforcement personnel, EMT's, Paramedics, military medics, or Physicians with emphasis on those in high risk tactical environments or who routinely work in situations where traditional EMS is not routinely available. The student will update basic trauma life support skills while in a tactical environment with an emphasis on self and buddy aid to bridge the time gap from the point and time of injury to the arrival of advanced medical support. This will include hemorrhage control to include the use of tourniquets and advanced hemostatic dressings as well as basic airway support. Additional topics will include medical management of blast injuries, environmental injuries and mass casualty incidents.

PREREQUISITES: Successful completion of Basic Law Enforcement Academy or equivalent as determined by Dean.
