TRAFFIC COLLISION INVESTIGATION (BASIC)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Basic Traffic Collision Investigation is a 40-hour course designed to satisfy the requirements of Vehicle Code Section 40600. This course will include: Vehicle Code Law as well as other code sections relating to the operation of a motor vehicle involved in a traffic accident; techniques for determining driver being under the influence of alcohol or drugs; and introductory methods of determining vehicle speed from skid marks.

PREREQUISITES: Successful completion of Basic Law Enforcement Academy or equivalent as determined by Dean.

MATERIALS NEEDED: Highlighted marker and a calculator with square root function are recommended.
