WEAPONLESS DEFENSE INSTRUCTOR (BASIC)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Basic Weaponless Defense Instructor is an 80-hour course of instruction designed for the experienced officer who conducts training for a law enforcement or related agency. Course work includes: current use-of-force techniques, policies, legal issues, and liability. The program will cover ground fighting: escape techniques, defense against violent assaults, and defense against armed assaults (clubs, knives, firearms).

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.

PREREQUISITES:

Successful completion of a Basic Law Enforcement Academy or equivalent as determined by Dean.
